<ul> <li>Respond and react immediately to auditory requests, instructions, monitor equipment, and perform auditory auscultation without auditory impediments.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>The HCP must be able to physically perform up to a 12-ho shift if required.</li> <li>Nurses only</li> </ul>
• The HCP must demonstrate dexterity and range of motion conducive to assisting patients and manipulating equipment without threatening harm or violating safety protocols.	<ul> <li>The HCP must be able to perform a patient assessment through visualization, direct and indirect auscultation, and detection of odors, palpitation and percussion.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>The HCP must be able to engage in and sustain physical activity that may require sitting, standing or walking for extended periods of time.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>The HCP must be able to physically apply up to 10 pounds pressure to bleeding sites or in performing CPR.</li> </ul>
